Dear Parents/Guardians

INFORMATION AND PROGRAMMES FOR TERM 4 2024

We welcome your child/ward back to school! We hope you and your child/ward had a restful and fulfilling September break.

I am pleased to share with you that Changkateers continue to excel in both academic and cocurricular areas. Our students have performed well at the recent **Mid-Year O Levels Mother Tongue (MT) examinations**. We achieved 100% passes in 4E Malay Language, 4N Malay Language, 4N Chinese Language, 5N Chinese Language and 5N Tamil Language. For MT Language 'B' syllabus, our students also achieved 100% passes for 4N Chinese Language and 5N Chinese Language.

At the **National School Games (NSG)** in Term 3, our 'C' Division Netball girls won Kuo Chuan Presbyterian Secondary School in the finals to achieve champion in their league. Our 'C' Division Badminton girls also fought hard to win third place in their league. This result is the best our Netball and Badminton girls have attained in recent years. Our Sepak Takraw boys won the third place overall in the National 'C' Division competition. We are so proud of all their achievements!

Individual Changkateers have strived hard to become the best in their respective fields. I wish to highlight some of their achievements. Gardner Sterling John (from 3B), Prisca Roshini D/O Richard Ravi (from 3E) and Nguyen Phuc Khang (from 3F) participated in our first ever collaboration with students from Metta School in Play Inclusive 2024 and emerged first in their Badminton competition. In the Schools Digital Media Awards 2024, Anjana Selva Kumar (from 4C) obtained first in her submission of the 'Digital Safety and Security' video. In the Better Internet Video Challenge 2024, Rico Tan Jun Hong (from 3B), Mok Zhong Sheng (from 3C), Chua Zhuo Xuan (from 3C) and Ng Jun Yi Celestina (from 3C) emerged champion with their creative video titled 'Canceled'. At the Chng San-Anderson Sahibba (Malay Scrabble) Invitational Competition, our team comprising Mohammad Shafiq Bin Mohammad Shahrizal (from 3A), Mariyah Bano Binte Munawar (from 3C), Nor Fazil Kurniawan Bin Nor Azman (from 3D) and Muhammad Hans Hazrig Bin Ishak (from 3D) won Anderson Team A to emerge champions. For the National Malay Language Poetry Recital Competition, Abdul Matin Bin Abdullah (from 1C), Naila Khalisya Bte Abdul Samad (from 2G), Nur Iqmal Yaqin Bin Shaerul Nizam (from 3D) and Herlina Eiliyah Binte Hadi Irwein (from 4C) won the overall champion and also the most creative performance. In the **Drone Odyssey** Challenge 2024, our Singapore Youth Flying Club students swept the 1st Runner Up and 2nd Runner Up prizes in the Drone Swarming Category. It is very inspiring to see our Changkateers from our **Talent Development Programme** gaining top honours in the various competitions they had participated in. This is made possible through the hard work of teachers too. Well done Changkateers!

Our staff constantly hones their craft and strives for excellence. Our Year Head (Lower Secondary), Mr Lim Pia Leong, was recently awarded **The Commendation Medal** during the National Day Awards 2024. The Commendation Medal is awarded to an individual who has distinguished himself through commendable performance and conduct or significant efficiency, competence and devotion to duty. Our Head of Department (Craft &Technology),

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Mr Samuel Ong Khim Ghee, was awarded **The Long Service Medal** at the National Day Awards 2024. The Medal may be awarded to any person who is of irreproachable character and whom the President is satisfied has completed at least 25 years service in the public service. Our Head of Department (Educational Support), Mr Abdul Nasir Bin Abdul Razzak has also facilitated the **Educational Support workshop** "**Belonging Actually**" for the fraternity and enriched the learning experience of the participants. His classroom stories and insights were practical and relatable and greatly inspired the attendees.

1. Ensuring Safety and Security of Students

1.1 Health Matters

In school, students are periodically reminded to continue to exercise personal and social responsibility. This includes maintaining good personal hygiene; reducing social interactions when feeling unwell; and wearing masks if medically vulnerable, in crowded areas, or when symptomatic. With many of our students and families having travelled overseas during the September holiday season, kindly check that your child/ward is well before sending them to school. We thank you for your kind cooperation to ensure that the school remains a safe place for all children to learn together.

1.2 Road Safety

Parents/guardians are encouraged to remind your child/ward on the importance of road safety inside and outside of the school. We seek your understanding to follow the correct traffic flow within the school compound and drop your child/ward only at the designated drop-off point at the foyer. Please also adhere to the speed limit (15 km/hr) in school especially when negotiating the right turn to the school drop off point at the foyer. To reduce congestion during wet weather, parents/guardians are to proceed toward the furthest end of the drop-off point so that more cars can be accommodated under the shelter. **Parents/guardians are also reminded that right turns at the school gate is prohibited from 6.30 am to 8.00 am.** If your child/ward is taking public transport, please also remind him/her to use the zebra crossings and designated footpaths when they are walking from the gate to the school building. Please encourage your child/ward to avoid crossing our school main gate during the peak period from 7.00 am to 7.40 am.

2. Enhancing Positive School Experience

2.1 Graduation Ceremony for 4NA / 4E / 5NA

We will be hosting the Graduation Ceremony for the Class of 2024 on **20 September**, **Friday from 3:15 PM to 5:45 PM**. During the ceremony, we will celebrate the achievements of our graduating Changkateers and relive the memorable experiences they have shared since Secondary One. The event will take place in the school hall. We warmly welcome all parents and guardians of Sec 4 and 5 students to join us for this special occasion. A separate invitation letter was sent via Parents Gateway on 21 August, where you can indicate your attendance.

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2.2 Post-Graduation Day Timetable

With the national examinations approaching, 4NA students will continue with the second phase of their Intensive Programme from 17 to 27 September. Meanwhile, 4E and 5NA students will resume their regular curriculum lessons from 23 to 27 September, and after-school consultations will be conducted for selected students.

From 30 September onwards, the students will be on study leave until the start of their national examinations. However, some selected students will be required to attend a Support Session, as notified by their subject teachers. Parents of these students will receive information through the Parents Gateway.

3.3 GCE N Level English Language Listening Comprehension (EL LC) and Early Dismissal for All Students on Tuesday, 10 Sep 2024
