WEIGHTED ASSESSMENTS FOR TERM 2 2019

1. In line with changes to School Based Assessments for Secondary 1 and 2 students, there will not be any mid-year examinations. Lessons will continue as usual.
2. The students will take weighted assessments in the form of written assessments such as class tests or alternative assessments such as projects, practicals, oral presentations etc.

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Rules and Regulations during Written Tests

1. Students who are absent from their written tests must produce a medical certificate.
2. Students will not be allowed to re-sit for any written tests, even if they have a valid medical certificate.
3. Students are required to bring their own writing and mathematical instruments such as calculators, set-squares, compasses, protractors and rulers as these will not be supplied.
4. Borrowing or sharing of stationery is not allowed.
5. Students are allowed to use MOE approved dictionaries and calculators.
6. If a student is caught cheating, such as:
 - a. attempting to obtain unfair assistance; OR
 - b. copying from another candidate or allowing his/her answers to be copied by another candidate(s); OR
 - c. possessing books, notes, memoranda or any other reference material not authorised for use in the examination; OR
 - d. possessing electronic devices (e.g. PDA, MP3 players), communication devices (e.g. mobile phones) and computerised aids (e.g. computerised wristwatches) capable of storing and displaying visual and verbal information prohibited in the examination / quarantine room; OR
 - e. removing any used or unused writing paper from the room,

he/she will be graded 'zero' for that paper. He/she may also be graded 'zero' for those papers he/she has sat for prior to the cheating offence and be barred from the rest of the examination.
